

Minutes of the February 8, 2016 Hampton City Council Budget Workshop Session.

The Council met at 6:00 pm. Members present were, Hickman, Davies, Mollenbeck, Pralle and Freie. Absent; Lukensmeyer. Mayor Boehmler called the workshop to order and the pledge of allegiance was recited. Also present were Police Chief Bob Schaefer, Public Works Director Doug Tarr and City Manager Ron Dunt.

Public comment: Mayor Boehmler stated that La Luz Hispana will be making a street closure request at Thursday's council meeting for a festival on June 4, 2016.

Tom Madden was unable to attend to discuss change orders related to the wwtp project. He will attend the February 11, 2016 council meeting.

The council then continued discussions on the FY17 budget. Discussions primarily focused on the funding levels of the library. The consensus was to increase funding to the library by \$1,500. This would put the contribution to \$83,500. Since there were no other budget items to discuss, the consensus of the council was to place the proposed FY17 budget on the February 11, 2016 council agenda for preliminary approval, to set March 7, 2016 as the date for the public hearing and final adoption of the FY17 budget.
