

**HAMPTON CITY COUNCIL
WORKSHOP MINUTES
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 19, 2016, 6:00 P.M.**

The Hampton City Council Workshop was called to order at City Council Chambers by Mayor Pro-Tem Dyanne Pralle at 6:00 p.m. Council members in attendance were, Richard Lukensmeyer, Jesse Mollenbeck, Jim Davies, Jay Hickman and Meghan Freie. Absent; Mayor Brook Boehmler. Mayor Pro-Tem Pralle invited those present to join in the Pledge of Allegiance to the U.S. flag.

Public Comment: Mayor Pro-Tem Pralle invited those wishing to make public comment to address the Council. There were none.

Mayor Pro-Tem Pralle presented the September Image of Pride award certificate to Dave and Amy Perez of 404 12th Ave NW.

Clay Miller, Hampton Fire Department, presented an update of the new brush truck and invited everyone outside to take a look at the truck. Miller indicated that the new truck was placed into service today. (The council took a brief recess to see the truck)

Joe Foley, SEH, presented information on his plan design for the Water Quality Sponsored Project. The Plan calls for Squaw Creek Stabilization from 4th St NE to East Park. The consensus of the council was favorable and no opposition to the preliminary plan was expressed.

Doug Tarr presented a review of the sidewalk ordinance primarily focusing on discussion of ordinance requirements for repair and replacement. No changes were proposed.

Ron explained to the council that there have been some employee concerns over the city mileage reimbursement policy. The current policy of reimbursing mileage at a rate of \$.36 per mile was last adjusted in 2002 or 2003. The consensus of the council was to have Ron draft a policy where the city rate would mirror the federal IRS rate. The draft will be considered at a future council meeting.

Doug presented some information on the need for no parking zones in the 500 Block of 1st St. SE. After much discussion the council consensus was to monitor the street for a few months and readdress later if necessary.
